Scripture

- To worship in a variety of settings & styles
- To serve with their families & peers in meeting needs in the community

Reason

Children, youth, & adults grow in faith when:

- They experience a "thinking climate' in worship and in learning groups
- They are encouraged to question, compare, & search the Scriptures
- They are open to answered prayer
- They engage other faith groups in dialog & learn to accept others also seeking God
